This outstanding one-bedroom duplex apartment with outside space is located on the top two floors of Cliff Road Studios, built in 1968 to a design by the architect Georgie Wolton. Properties in this building come up for sale extremely rarely.

The flat has a fabulous double-height reception / dining room on the lower floor, with large skylights and fine views over pretty communal gardens at the rear. There is also a separate kitchen separated by a sliding door. An open-tread timber staircase leads to the mezzanine level, where there is an open-plan bedroom, as well as a dressing room and a bathroom.

The apartment is located on the fourth and fifth floors (there is no lift). It has a shared roof terrace, as well as use of the quiet communal gardens, off-street parking and storage space in the basement. Cliff Road Studios was built as a series of live/work spaces for artists. The layout would lend itself very well to someone working from home.
