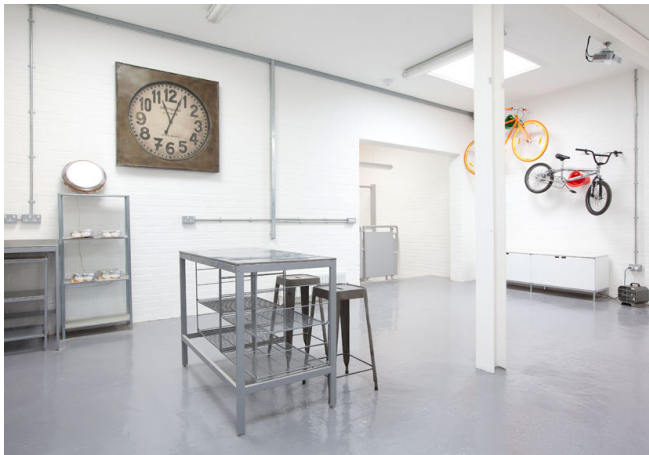

Heathfield I

This excellent house is a rare example of a former industrial space in a village setting in Sussex. The Workshop features a spectacular kitchen / dining / living room with high ceilings and painted brick walls. There are three bedrooms, one with an en suite bathroom, a further reception room and a small garden / off street parking area at the front of the house. The approximate gross internal area is 171 sq m / 1,840 sq ft.

The building is a former furniture workshop, whose recent conversion was overseen by the Brighton-based Atkins Blair Ings Richardson Architects. The detailing throughout has been kept intentionally industrial, with steel balustrades and resin floors and the standard of fittings and fixtures kept high throughout. The energy efficiency of the building was a significant consideration for the architects and extensive insulation has been fitted.

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Heathfield I

The house is located in the centre of Heathfield, a large and popular village (it also sometimes referred to as a small town) in East Sussex. The house is within easy walking distance of a range of shops and services, but also within walking distance of beautiful countryside (the Cuckoo Trail footpath passes close to the house). The larger towns of Hawkhurst and Tunbridge Wells are within easy driving distance. The coast is approximately fifteen miles away (with Eastbourne being the closest coastal town but Brighton and Hastings also being easily accessible). Heathfield is well served for schools and has a number of primary schools and a college.
