Mulberry House

Designed by the award-winning practice John Smart Architects, Mulberry House is an exceptional terraced house in the sought-after Conservation Area of Camberwell Grove.

The property is one of four houses created from a Victorian building, known collectively as St John's Orchard. It combines a historic fabric with exciting modern interiors. The design is a reinvention of the traditional home, comprising a series of highly dynamic living spaces programmed for a variety of family uses.

Accommodation is set over five floors and measures approximately 4,132 sq ft. At the front of the property is a garden and an off-street parking space. To the rear is a landscaped garden measuring more than 50m in length. There are far-reaching panoramic views from the upper rooms of the house, as well as from the fantastic roof terrace at the top.

The architects have designed a bespoke timber staircase that winds its way through the house, and the specification throughout is of a very high standard. This is a family home of grand proportions and rare quality, perfectly suited to 21st-century living.

Grove Park is situated within walking distance of the Overground stations at Denmark Hill and East Dulwich, offering direct trains to London Bridge, Victoria and Farringdon. There are several excellent state and public schools in the area, including Dulwich College, James Allen's Girls' School and Alleyn's School. The Dog Kennel Hill Primary School is a short walk away.

John Smart Architects was given an RIBA award for its new-build housing on Dog Kennel Hill in East Dulwich, and it has previously been identified by Wallpaper* magazine as one of the world's best emerging practices.
